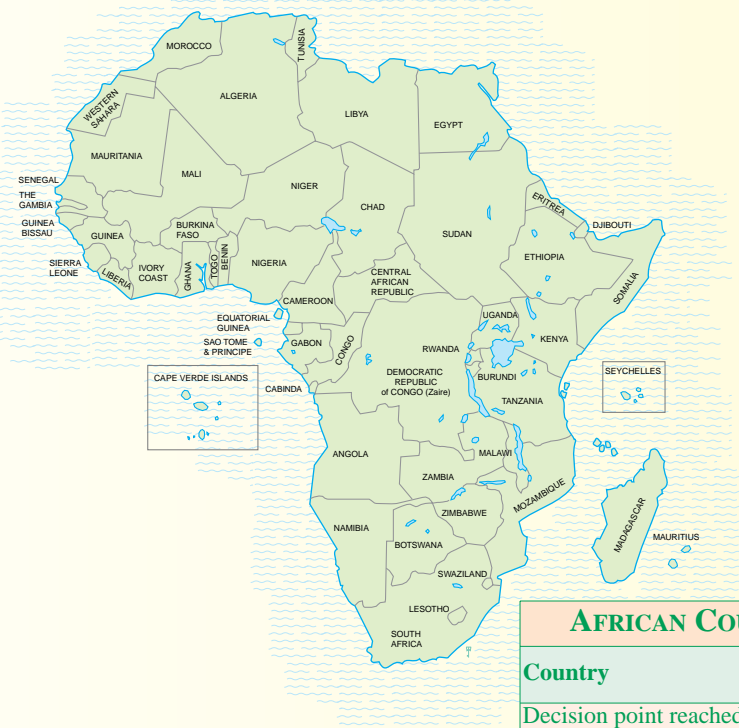

TABLE NOTES:- Columns 1 to 9 contain information from the **Human Development Report 2002 (HDR)** of the **United Nations Development Programme**. The total external debt figures in **Col. 10** are from the **World Bank's 2002 World Development Indicators**. **Col. 1:** The **Human Development Index (HDI)** measures a country's (out of 173) achievements in terms of life expectancy, educational attainment and adjusted real income. **Col. 2:** The **Human Poverty Index** for developing countries (**HPI-1**) is calculated by using the probability at birth of not surviving to age 40, the adult illiteracy rate, the percentage of population not using improved water sources, and the percentage of children under five who are underweight. It covers 88 developing countries with Uruguay ranked no. 1 and Niger no. 88. **Col. 4:** **Life Expectancy** is at birth in years. **Col. 5:** Is the % of adults living with **HIV/AIDS**. **Col. 6 & 7:** Is the number of **Malaria** and **TB** cases per 100,000 people. **Col. 8 & 9:** the % of the population using adequate sanitation facilities and improved water sources.
