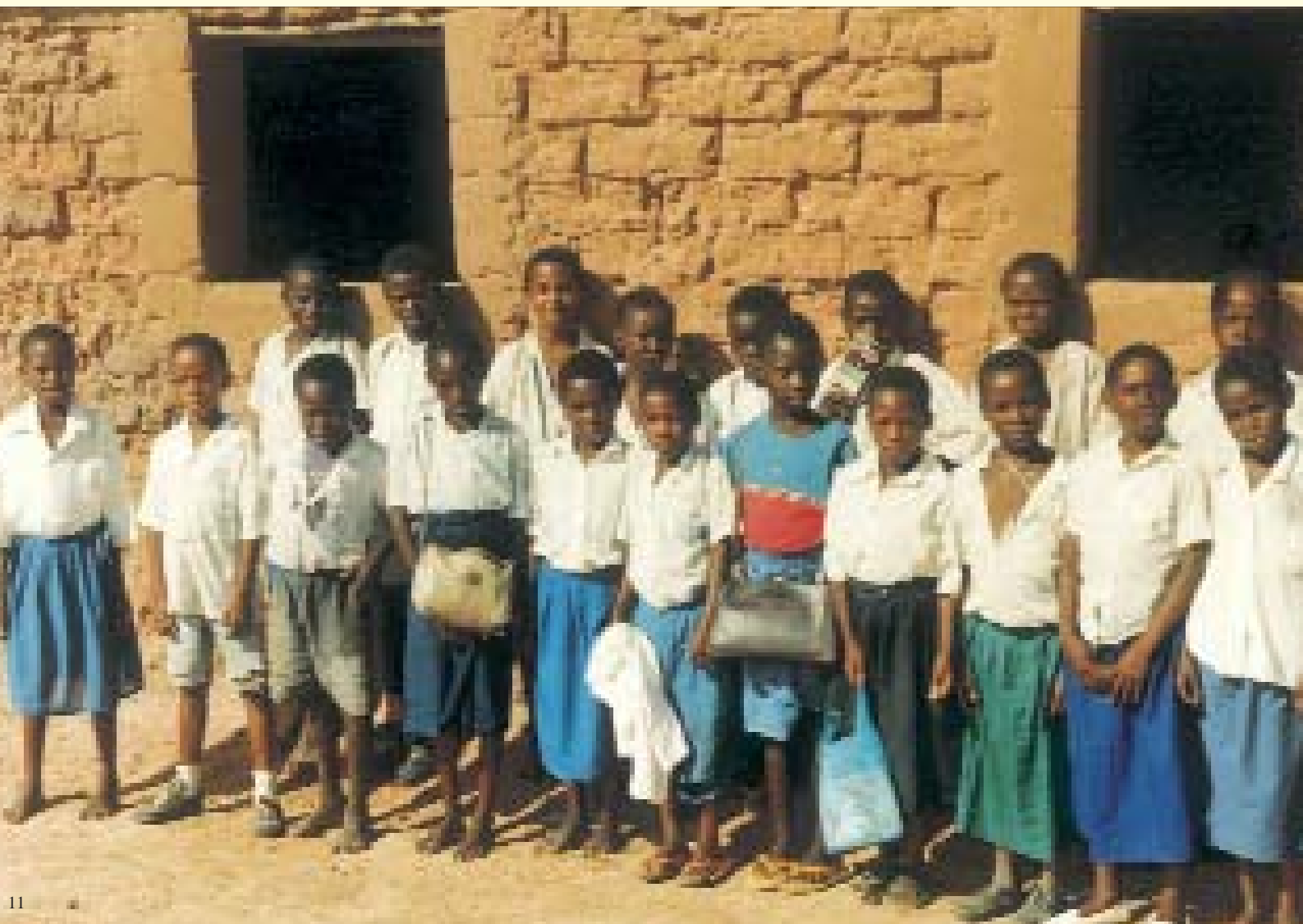

All the photographs in the 2004 calendar, including those on the front and back covers, were taken by Fr. Frank Nolan W.F. in Tanzania.

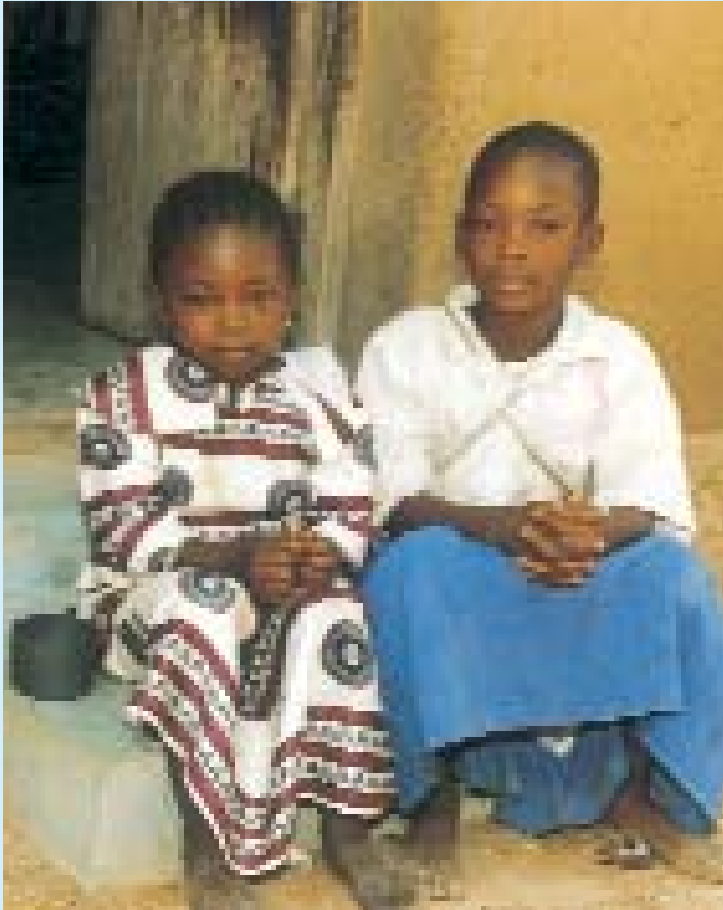
